


How to find us:



We are located within the beautiful Rickmansworth Aquadrome, a water sports centre and local nature reserve.

There is no formal postal address but please follow these directions to find us: **(Sat-Nav: WD3 1NB)**

Travel to Rickmansworth and locate the Tesco supermarket, with Tesco on your right please continue on along the Harefield Road, after 150 metres turn right into Frogmore Lane and proceed over the hump back bridge. You are now in the Aquadrome, continue along the road and park in the main car park. The club is located through the trees and can be accessed via the double gates that are found opposite the timber cafe building.

Formed in 1973, the club has always been based in South-West Hertfordshire and our current home is located within the grounds of the Rickmansworth Aquadrome.

Built and opened by club members in 1994 the canoe polo pitch has long been envied by other South-East based clubs. From this facility we are able to maintain and develop six canoe polo squads and also use the sheltered nature of its location for recreational training.

Many of our more experienced paddlers arrange trips to places like Holme Pierrepont, the Dart and the Tryweryn in Wales, if you join us you will receive full details of all the clubs trips and events.
